SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Submit a 50-80 page unpublished manuscript of original poetry in English. Please number the pages of your manuscript and include a table of contents and an acknowledgments page for any previously published poems.

***Manuscripts by current and former students and close friends of the contest judge will not be considered.**

***All manuscripts are considered for publication at Barrow Street, both within the contest period and outside its parameters.**

ONLINE SUBMISSION

Use our Online Submission Manager to enter your contact information, upload the file containing your manuscript, and pay the contest entry fee. Please include your full contact info in the submission manager only. Follow the instructions on the submission manager main page and be sure to select "Book contest" from the genre drop down menu in order to pay the contest entry fee. The author's name, address, and telephone number should not appear anywhere in the manuscript. You will need to upload the file containing your manuscript in either .doc(x) or .pdf format.

Please note that you can only submit one manuscript at a time, so if you are submitting multiple manuscripts, you will need to follow these instructions for each one. Please submit a blind copy of your manuscript. Your name or any other identifying markers should not appear on the manuscript anywhere. Simultaneous submissions are allowed, but if your manuscript is selected for publication by another press, you will need to withdraw your manuscript from this contest using the online submission manager. Contest entry fees are non-refundable.

As Barrow Street is a small, mostly volunteer-run non-profit press, charging submission fees during our contest periods is a necessity. However, we understand that contest fees are often an

obstacle that prevents many worthy writers from sending their work. We offer a limited number of discounted contest entries, available upon request.
